INTRODUCTION

ENPC, the premier evidence based emergency nursing pediatric education course, developed by pediatric emergency nurses, provides a standardized body of pediatric emergency nursing knowledge to improve the care of pediatric patients. It provides early intervention and expert care from birth to adolescence.

ENPC uses a systematic approach to the initial assessment with the Pediatric Assessment Triangle and A-I mnemonic tools. This 1.5 day hands-on intensive course combines classroom learning with interactive scenarios.

Verification of successful course completion is based on passing both the written exam and skill-based hands-on assessment.
