TNCC Fast Track is an abbreviated version of the TNCC course. It was developed for nurses who need to renew their TNCC verification card and are more comfortable with independent study. These students will only attend the day 2 portion of the didactic instruction and take the same skill station and online exam assessment required for course completion.

TNCC Challenge offers the opportunity for experienced nurses in the TNP process to complete their certification without any classroom lectures or pre-course module review. It requires independent study to be successful. Requirements include attendance at day 2 of class to test independently for the TNP skill station. The online test is to be completed within 7 days of class attendance for certification. A TNCC book and study materials are not provided.

Course Cancellation Policy: Course participants should contact the course director, Melissa Komrska, by email or phone as early as possible when they find that they cannot attend the course.

6 weeks' notice is preferred. You may be able to transfer to another course date hosted by Northeast Indiana Chapter 365 one time only. If you are unable to attend the course and do not notify the course director prior to the course, no refund will be given, and your registration will not be transferred to another course date.
